- Admission will be given subject to the vacancies in each class.
- Admissions are granted strictly on the merit of the candidate. Any effort at seeking admission through such dubious means such as offering a donation will "ipso fact" debar the candidate from getting admission.
- Letters of recommendation from any source or personal contact or, behalf of the applicant will not be considered by the school authorities. They are positive hindrance to the candidate's possible admission.
- Children joining Nursery or the Junior KG, Senior KG classes and Std. I have to produce an original birth Certificate in support of the date of birth entered in the admission form. This must be submitted at the time of admission and becomes the property of the school and will not be returned,
- A new pupil who has attended a recognized school cannot be admitted without a Leaving Certificate from the school last attended and in the case of pupils coming from schools outside Maharashtra State: the certificate must be countersigned by the inspector of the State from which the pupil comes. This must be submitted at the time of admission.
- A new pupil in Std. II and above who has attended a non-recognized school must obtain permission -from the Inspector of Schools for admission to this school. The pupil must also produce an affidavit in the given format signed by the parents or guardian before a magistrate and the Leaving Certificate of the non-recognized School must also be submitted at the time of admission.
- All documents once submitted become the property of the school and cannot be returned, and all fees once paid are non-refundable in part or in full.
- A pupil seeking re-admission within three month of withdrawal must pay the entire fees of the period of absence.
- In the case of the children in the Pre-Primary section, should the government enforce any age restriction different to the one currently prevailing in the school, parents would have to comply with the regulation.
